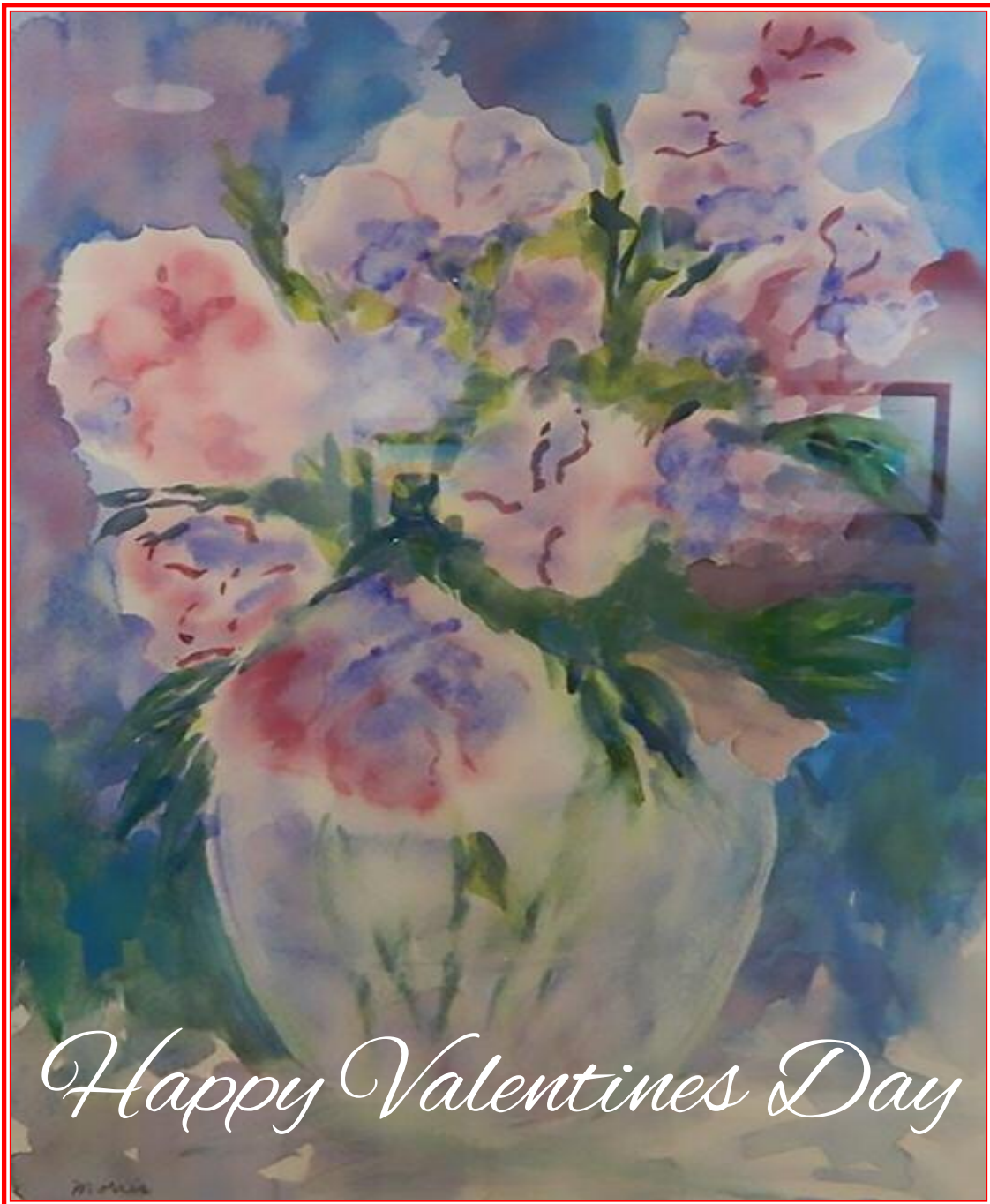

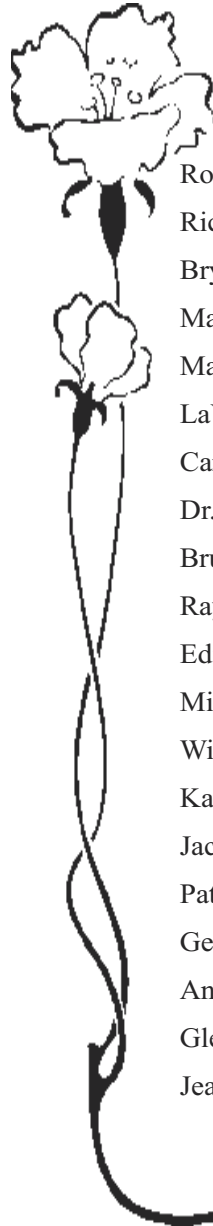

HELEN SEBOLD**
