Congratulations to Val on her award for SHC Star Employee of the Month January 2022!




#### BIRTHDAY LUNCHEON

### CUP OF JOE WITH PERRIGO



#### MOVIE MANIA WITH DR. PAUL AND MARIA TRUDEAU

Join us on January 24 at 1:30 p.m. for "The Railway Man". The Railway Man is a 2013 British-Australian war film directed by Jonathan Teplitzky. It is an adaptation of the 1995 autobiography of the same name by Eric Lomax, and stars Colin Firth, Nicole Kidman, Jeremy Irvine, and Stellan Skarsgard. It premiered at the 2013 Toronto International Film Festival on 6 September 2013.



The movie is set on two timelines, the current and in the 1940s during World War II. In the movie, we meet young British soldiers who were held as war prisoners by the Japanese Military. Among the British soldiers is Eric Lomax, a signals engineer by profession. Lomax is a British officer who is captured by the Japanese in Singapore and sent to a Japanese POW camp. There he is forced to work on the Thai-Burma Railway north of the Malay Peninsula. Lomax is the main protagonist who faces severe psychological effects in the modern day due to the severe conditions he was exposed to by his Japanese masters. He survives the torture, is rescued by American soldiers, and lives to tell the story.




